

Cross Stitch	
cross stitch	Stitches which form a cross
	shape.
needle	A sharp pointed implement
	(usually steel).
pattern	A guide or diagram that you
•	follow to make clothes or other
	things using a needle and thread.
thread	A fine cord of twisted fibres
	used in sewing and weaving.
Printing	
print	A picture or design printed from
	a block or plate or copied from a
	painting by photography.
printing	A material engraved for printing
block	on paper or fabric
reflection	A geometric transformation
	resulting in a mirror image.
relief print	Printing from raised images.
triple print	Use three different colours to
	make a printed design by
	removing parts of the printing
	block.

axle	Rod on which one or more wheels
	can turn.
cam	Specially shaped wheel, or one
	with a hole off-centre; when it
	rotates, anything resting on its
	edge will bob up and down, as in a
	pull-along toy.
cam follower	Device which rests on and follows
	the movement of the cam.
clamp	To secure work or equipment to a
	table.
crank handle	A hand tool consisting of a
	rotating shaft with parallel
	handle.
dowel	Wood cut to a cylindrical shape,
	available in various widths.
drill	Tool for making holes in wood,
	plastic or metal.
frame	A structure made by joining
	together a number of pieces of
	wood, metal, card or plastic.
saw	Cutting tool.
vice	Holding device for components or
	materials so they may be worked
	on.
washers	Used to keep wheels in place on
	the axle.
wheel	Circular frame or disc which
	rotates about a centre, enabling
	linear (straight-line) movement
	from circular motion.
