

Key Vocabulary	
roots	<b>Roots</b> take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground.
stem	The <b>stem</b> holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the <b>roots</b> to the <b>leaves</b> and <b>flowers</b> .
leaves	<b>Leaves</b> catch sunlight to help the plant to make its own food.
flowers	Flowers attract insects and birds.
petals	Petals are the colourful part of the flower.
fruit	<b>Fruit</b> contains the plant's <b>seeds</b> . Sometimes humans try to grow <b>fruit</b> without <b>seeds</b> because it's easier to eat.
seed	Seeds grow into new plants.
bulb	Bulbs grow into new plants.
