
## Knowledge Organiser History Castles

<b>Castle</b> A type of home that was built to protect the people inside.	
<b>Medieval</b> A period of time from the 11 <sup>th</sup> century to the 16 <sup>th</sup> century.	Motte a Bailey
King/Queen Male/Female ruler of a country.	balley
Lord and Lady Important people of high rank who run and own castles.	
Battlements The top of the castle wall with raised and lowered sections.	
<b>Portcullis</b> A strong iron gate that can be raised and lowered to block enemies.	
<b>Drawbridge</b> A bridge that can be lowered or raised to enter or exit a castle.	A
<b>Moat</b> A deep ditch that surrounds a castle. It can be filled with or without water.	1
<b>Turrets</b> A small tower built on the castle at the corner or on top of a larger tower.	Concent
<b>Keep</b> A strong tower built within castles for defence.	Concent
Bailey The outer wall of a castle.	outer bail
Arrow Slits A narrow vertical slit in the wall for shooting through.	
Defend Protect from harm or danger.	
Attack An aggressive and violent act against a person or place.	
Siege Cutting off essential supplies with the aim of making people inside	
the castle surrender.	
Motte A mound forming the site or a castle.	outer gate
