

## Reception Newsletter Our topic this half term is Gardeners' World!




Hello and welcome back after the Easter break! We are really looking forward to exploring our new topic, 'Gardeners' World!' ## Literacy Resulting







Reading and writing will be our big focus this half-term. In class, we will continue with our daily phonics and reading books at your child's phonic level. We will use carefully selected books to hook the children into our topic, including stories and non-fiction texts. Additionally, we will be asking the children to write more words independently and form sentences using finger spaces, correct letter formation and full stops.

In maths, we will continue to count on and back, compare, order, subitise and explore ways of making numbers to 10. We will start to add by counting on and take away numbers within 10 and also recall number bonds to 5 and some bonds to 10. We will look at the numbers to 20 and understand them as 10 and another number. Furthermore, we will explore spatial reasoning through matching, manipulating, rotating, combing and separating shapes.









Our topic this half term is 'Gardeners' World!' We will be exploring the changes that happen in Spring and exploring the natural environment around us. We will be looking at and naming some plants, flowers and trees as well as understanding how they change and grow through planting broad beans. We will look at the plants which we eat and explore ways to keep healthy, including eating a balanced diet. Lots of the children have shown a keen interest in bugs so we will be huntina for minibeasts around environment and finding out how we can care and look after them. In particular, we will look at caterpillars and compare their life cycles to that of humans.
